“By providing primary and specialty care closer to home, patients can focus on treatment, not transportation,” Kiefer said. “Local care also allows for more personalized service, with healthcare providers who are familiar with the community they serve.”

Tying into that need, Kiefer also shared how the company’s transition from Chambers Health into **OmniPoint Health** is more than just a name change, the organization is transforming into a regional health system, with a focus on personalized care.
