

Statements required in notice if the proposed tax rate does not exceed the lower of the no-new-revenue tax rate or the voter-approval tax rate, as prescribed by Tax Code §26.061.

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$ 0.27869 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Chambers County Public Hospital District No. 1

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$ <u>0.27869</u>	per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$ <u>0.236412</u>	per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$ <u>0.340194</u>	per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2022 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Chambers County Public Hospital District No. 1 from the same properties in both the 2021 tax year and the 2022 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that Chambers County Public Hospital No. 1 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Chambers County Public Hospital District No. 1 is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2022 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 22, 2002 at OmniPoint Wellness Center, 2022 S. Main St., Anahuac, TX 77514

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, CCPHD No. 1 is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Directors of CCPHD No. 1 at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
